### Last Chance

★ **Walt Kuhn: 'American Modern'** (closes on Saturday) The 100th anniversary of the Armory Show has occasioned a fresh look at Walt Kuhn, an organizer of the 1913 show whose own paintings have been somewhat marginalized. It includes several large-scale figure paintings on loan from museums and is accompanied by a full catalog. "Sleeping Girl," a portrait of an exhausted dancer slumped over her dressing table (from the Ogunquit Museum of American Art), adds a starkly outlined, Matisse-like body to a head we recognize from Brancusi's "Sleeping Muse." Here too are later paintings of entertainers, dancers and clowns, the sort of popular, down-to-earth subject matter that Kuhn liked to call "buckeye" and others have seen as kitsch.
