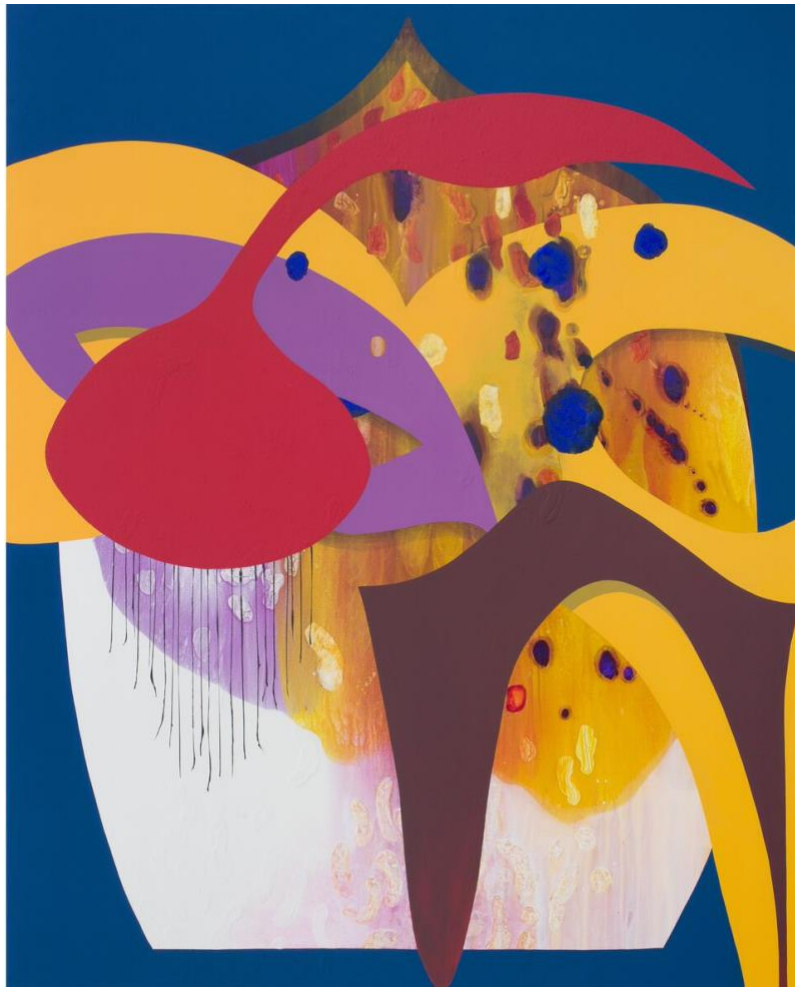

Kaleidoscope Worldview: Carrie Moyer at DC Moore Gallery, New York

Now open is the latest instalment of Carrie Moyer's exploration of her Pleasure Principle. Comparing the rational with the sensual, the artist presents her latest exhibition "Pagan's Rapture" at the DC Moore Gallery. The gallery's New York venue will host Moyer's artworks until March 22, 2018.

This is the artist's second solo show with the gallery and is a reaffirmation of Moyer's Pleasure Principle. It is the joyful sustenance and declaring that the end of times is not near. The artist's latest work rejects our relentless focus on the zeitgeist. Instead, she proposes a kaleidoscopic worldview that embraces the sensual as much the rational through the materiality of paint and color. The artworks depict logo-like silhouettes of flora, fauna, body-parts, vessels and planets all collapsed in a history of signs. These flattened archetypes and cheeky references often perform as compositional rigging around which cascades of paint, glitter and light flow.

Carrie Moyer (b. 1960) is an American painter. She earned a BFA from Pratt Institute (1985), an MA in Computer Graphics from New York Institute of Technology (1990) and an MFA from Bard College (2000). Moyer is a Professor in the Art and Art History Department and Director of the Graduate Program at Hunter College, as well as Vice Chair of the Board of Governors at Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture in Maine. Her recent exhibitions include the 2017 Whitney Museum of American Art Biennial curated by Christopher Lew and Mia Locks; Carrie Moyer: Sirens at DC Moore Gallery, NY, (2016); Three Graces: Polly Apfelbaum, Tony Feher and Carrie Moyer at the Everson Museum of Art, Syracuse, NY, among others.

"Pagan's Rapture" runs from February 8 through March 22, 2018, at DC Moore Gallery, 535 W 22nd St, New York, NY 10011, USA.
