Duane Michals: Mischievous Eye - D C Moore Gallery

In Duane Michals: Mischievous Eye, viewers will see the photographer's gently sardonic take on life and mortality in new works as well as earlier pieces. Some of the best images play on the very human desire to be immortal, often with unintended results but always with a certain inescapable logic. Other photographs riff on art history or popular culture, twisting the expectations of the audience with a touch of humor. It's not often you can go to an art gallery to laugh at the contradictions of human existence while recognizing your own frailties, but with this show you will.
